## **Hedgehog Class RE: Judaism**

This term in RE, we are learning about Judaism. As part of this, children should learn to do the following things: know that Jewish people live all over the world but that Israel is considered to be very special to them; recognise the Star of David as a symbol of Judaism representing the creation story; understand what the Torah is and why it is special to Jewish people; and explain why the Sabbath is important to Jewish people and how they observe this.

Below are some suggested activities for you to do with your child to support their learning in this area. Please feel free to choose as many as you like and to come up with your own ideas.
